Four key characteristics define the essence of the Boys & Girls Club of West-Central WI.

1. Dedicated Youth Facility:

The Boys & Girls Club is a place designed solely for youth programs. It's a safe place to go.

2. Year-round:

The Club is open weekdays after school and into the evening and in the summer; when kids need us most.

3. Professional Staff:

Every Club has full-time, trained youth development professionals providing positive role models and mentors. Volunteers provide key supplementary support and expertise to enhance our services. We have a ratio of 1 staff to 15 children or less.

4. Available/Affordable to All Youth:

Fees are low, and no child is turned away for lack of ability to pay. Contact us for additional information about our scholarship program.

Weekly Themes: Each week includes daily fun with activities such as: swimming, field trips, outside activities, science lessons, visits to the library, educational enrichment, cooking, fishing & more!

Milwaukee St. Site Information—(Ages 7-12)

Minimum ages for summer: 7 years old & have completed 1st grade

SUMMER DAY CAMP: (ages 7-12) 11:30 am – 5:30 pm; Cost: \$15 a day; \$15 for the first child in a family/household, \$10 for each additional child from the same household attending on the same day.

SUMMER DROP-IN HOURS: Free for Registered Members. Milwaukee St Site: 7:30 – 11:30 am

We pick up after the last class of the day from TASD Summer PACK. (No extra charge.)

Summer is on a Punch Card System – Summer Program uses a punch card system. You purchase a punch card worth 5 days. We keep it here at the Club and mark each day your child attends. When you have used all 5 days you purchase a new card.

Summer Registration Fee: Register Early and its FREE!

It's FREE in March. April its \$10. May 1 –Aug 24 the registration fee is \$20 per child

Punch Card Prices: *1 punch card must be purchased at registration for each child.*

\$75 per Regular Punch Card – Punch cards must be purchased before the child attends summer Day Camp.

\$50 per Additional Child punch card—May only be purchased when registering more than one child from the same household. Discounted rate applies only when 2 or more children from the same household attend on the same day.

Annual Registration Fee: All members in summer day camp must be registered Members. The Annual Registration fee is **\$24 per child.** (Annual Membership runs Jan. 1—Dec. 31)

Some field trips require an additional fee. Watch for more information about the trips; there will be separate sign up & payment information.

We recommend youth wear Boys & Girls Club T-shirts on field trip days. Shirts are available for purchase at the front desk. Cost is \$8 each.

Registration, membership and program fees are Non-refundable and must be used by Dec. 31st, 2018

Teen Center—Superior Ave. Site Minimum Age: 12 & have completed 6th grade

SUMMER DROP-IN HOURS: 1:30 pm – 5:30 pm, FREE to registered club members. Come any day!

JUNIOR LEADER PROGRAM (Minimum Ages 13)

Youth may participate as Junior Leaders from 7:30 am – 1:30 pm at the Milwaukee St. Site.

The Junior Leader program is a job skills training opportunity through which teens gain valuable volunteer work experience to help them prepare for the workforce. Youth have opportunities to co-lead games & activities with staff, complete kitchen or office work, and do a variety of tasks to

learn skills. Youth must apply and be accepted to participate in this program. There is no cost for this program, but you must be a registered club member. Contact the Club to apply.

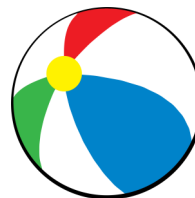
